Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The names and addresses of the person(s) who are the trustees of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Article third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carry on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations that said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

**BYLAWS For
Royal Oak High School Varsity Dance Team Booster Club
Royal Oak, Michigan**

Adopted: May 14, 2009

**ARTICLE I
NAME AND ORGANIZATION**

- Section 1. **NAME:** The Organization shall be known as ROHS Varsity Dance Team Booster Club.
- Section 2. **ORGANIZATION:** The Club was organized on June 1, 2007 and established as a non-profit organization with a fiscal year end of April 30th.
- Section 3. **OFFICERS OF INCORPORATION:** The names and addresses of the persons who are the trustees of the club at the time of this amendment are as follows:

Member at Large: Tracey Robinson, 806 Park, Royal Oak, MI 48067

**ARTICLE II
PURPOSE**

- Section 1. **PURPOSE:** The Club is organized exclusively to provide financial and moral support to the ROHS Varsity Dance Team. However, the Club shall seek neither to direct the administrative or coaching activities of the Team, nor to control its policies. The Club shall provide financial support to include making distributions that qualify as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or any revision of said Code) to be used exclusively to benefit the members and coaches of the ROHS Varsity Dance Team. Further, the activities of the Club shall include and encompass the following:
- (a) The Club shall encourage full participation in the sport of dance by all persons, regardless of age, race, religious creed, color, nation origin or ancestry; to improve or advance amateur dance in all forms.
 - (b) Support uniform standards of dance proficiency in accordance with the guidelines of Universal Dance Association (UDA).
 - (c) Generally, to take all steps necessary to regulate and govern itself for the advancement of dance, including the raising of funds to support the activities of the Club and the ROHS Varsity Dance Team by dues, sales of publications, and private fundraisers, provided that none of the income of the Club contributes to the private profit of any of its members or any individual whatsoever.
 - (d) To sponsor and participate or assist in the sponsorship of competitions for the purpose of encouraging the growth of interest of young persons and the general public in dance and in connection therewith to assist financially or otherwise in accordance with the rules of the Club and UDA.

- (e) To assist those persons who have demonstrated a continuing interest in dance and a devotion to the stated charitable and educational purposes of the Club and who are in need of financial assistance in order to continue their education in dance and/or to cover the costs of all or any part of the expenses incurred for coaching, competitions, travel, uniforms and equipment and/or tuition, board and lodging of any participants while attending team approved activities.

ARTICLE III **OFFICERS**

- Section 1. **OFFICERS:** The officers shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Member At Large.
- Section 2. **ELECTION OF OFFICERS:** The President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Member At Large shall be elected by the members at their first regular meeting, by show of hands and shall hold office for at least one (1) year, but no longer than four (4) years. The officers may fill any vacancy among the executive board by the vote of the majority of those present at the regular meeting of the club.
- Section 3. **METHOD OF ELECTION:**
- (a) **NOMINATIONS:** The outgoing officers of the club shall nominate candidates to fill the vacancies on the executive board.
 - (b) **OTHER NOMINATIONS:** Nominations, from members entitled to vote, will be accepted from the floor at the general meeting and shall have the member's consent.
 - (c) **METHOD OF VOTING:** Vote shall be by show of hands, and those receiving the greatest number shall be elected.
- Section 4. **ELIGIBILITY:**
- (a) At least twenty-one (21) years of age.
 - (b) A member in good standing
 - (c) A parent or guardian of an ROHS Varsity Dance Team member.
 - (d) No ROHS coaches, staff, or administrative person shall be eligible to serve as an officer, nor shall a spouse of any of the aforementioned ROHS employees.
- Section 5. **TERMS OF OFFICE:** The terms of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Member at Large will last at least one (1) year, but no longer than four (4) years.
- Section 6. **VACANCIES/REMOVAL:** In the event of a vacancy on the Officer Board or Standing Committee Chairperson, the Officer Board will elect a successor to complete the entire length of the term. The resignation of any Officer or Chairperson shall be in writing and addressed to the Club. Any Officer may be removed by a two-thirds majority vote of the entire Officer Board and he/she will be provided notice of the complete action within thirty days. Three consecutive unexcused absences from Officer and/or Full Member monthly meetings will be considered resignation from the Officer Board.

ARTICLE IV
POWERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS

- Section 1. **DUTIES OF PRESIDENT:** It shall be the duty of the President to take charge of the Club, to preside at all meetings of the Club and the Membership. In particular, the President shall be responsible for all Varsity fundraising activities. The President shall have the entire supervision and management of the Club and its property, pending the action of the Membership; the power to suspend any member for violating the Bylaws or Regulations of the Club, pending the approval of the Membership, and to call special and regular club meeting. It shall be the duty of the President to act as spokesperson for the ROHS Varsity Dance Team Booster Club. The President, together with the Treasurer and Head Coach, shall sign all agreements and contracts made by the Club, upon the approval of the Membership.
- Section 2. **DUTIES OF THE VICE PRESIDENT:** It shall be the duty of the Vice President to assist the President in the discharge of his/her duties and in his/her absence to assume those duties and officiate in his/her stead. In particular, the Vice President shall be responsible for all JV fundraising activities. He/She may agree to immediately become President for the unexpired term if the office of President is vacated through resignation, leave of absence, or death, and no other member indicates her/his interest in becoming President.
- Section 3. **DUTIES OF THE TREASURER:** The Treasurer shall have charge of the Varsity funds of the Club and shall keep a record of all receipts and disbursements and shall render a written report when requested by the President. The President, Secretary, and Head Coach shall have the power whenever they deem necessary to appoint an acting Treasurer. The funds shall be deposited in the name of the Club in a bank approved by the Officers, or in securities approved by the Officers. The Treasurer shall be responsible for all federal, state, and local governmental filings (i.e. tax returns and annual reports). The fiscal year of the Club shall end on the last day of April.
- Section 4. **DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY:** It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the minutes of all meetings of the Club and the Officers; to supervise all reports and documents connected with the business of the Club; to supervise the correspondence of the Club; to prepare and issue notices of all meetings and activities of the Club and the Officers. He/she shall notify the membership after each election of officers and shall notify Royal Oak High School Athletic Director of any amendments to the By-Laws and shall also notify the ROHS Athletic Director of the results of the election of the officer within thirty (30) days thereafter.
- Section 5. **MEMBER AT LARGE:** Assists and advises Coaches and Officers with various duties and responsibilities. Must be a person with at least a year of experience as a former board member of the ROHS Varsity Dance Team Booster Club.
- Section 5. **MEETINGS:** The Officers shall communicate prior to every Full Membership meeting during the regular school year. The Vice President shall state by the President, or in his/her absence, the date of such meetings.
- Section 6. **AUTHORITY:** The Head Coach shall have final authority over all decisions made by the Club Officers and Membership. The Officers shall have entire authority in the management of affairs and finances of the Club and shall have general control of all its property. All rights and powers connected therein shall be vested in them, under the direction of the Head Coach.

- Section 7. RULES: They shall make such rules as they deem proper respecting the use of the Club's property and make rules for their own government and for the government of the committees appointed by them. These Club policies shall be reviewed at least once every two years.
- Section 8. BONDING: The Treasurer shall be bonded. In the absence of a bonded Treasurer, no check shall be issued without the signature of both the President and Treasurer of the Board of Directors.
- Section 9. STANDING COMMITTEES: The Officers shall appoint all standing committees with full authority over them and shall appoint such other committees as shall seem to them necessary.
- Section 10. EXPENDITURES AND REVENUE: The Officers shall prepare and submit for approval or amendment to the spring meeting a budget of anticipated expenditures for the following school year together with proposals of sources of revenue to meet same.

ARTICLE V
STANDING COMMITTEES

- Section 1. NAMES: The standing committees shall be:
- (a) Banquet Committee
- And such other committees as the Offices may deem necessary. Standing Committees may be combined or divided at the discretion of the Board and shall consist of one (1) or more members. They shall be appointed annually by the Board at the regular meeting after the annual election, if necessary. Each Standing Committee must choose a Chairperson to lead the committee and act as chief contact person.

ARTICLE VI
MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. **GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE:** None.

Section 2. **CLASSES FOR MEMBERSHIP:**

- (a) Full
- (b) Associate
- (c) Professional
- (d) Corporate

Section 3. **FULL MEMBERSHIP:**

Privileges:

- (a) One vote per membership
- (b) Adult Family members may hold office responsibilities:
 - (a) Attend all General and Full Membership meetings
 - (b) Participate in fundraisers

Section 4. **ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP:** These are issued to family members and friends who wish to support the activities of the ROHS Varsity Dance Team Booster Club. This membership level requires no participation or obligations. Associate members may not serve as an officer of the Club and shall not be entitled to vote, nor shall they have any claim on the assets or property of the Club.

Section 5. **PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP:** Professional memberships may be given to the coaches, teachers, and administration of ROHS who wish to support the Club. Professional members may not be nominated or elected to serve as an Officer of the Club. They shall not be entitled to vote, nor shall they have any claim on the assets or property of the Club.

Section 6. **CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP:** Corporate memberships may be issued to business offering a minimum donation to the Club. Corporate members may not be nominated or elected to serve as an Officer of the Club. They shall not be entitled to vote, nor shall they have any claim on the assets or property of the Club.

Section 7. **TEAM REPRESENTATION:** One of the elected Captains of the ROHS Varsity Dance Team shall attend and represent the team members' interests at all Club meetings. Team representatives may not be nominated or elected to serve as an Officer of the Club. They shall not be entitled to vote, nor shall they have any claim on the assets or property of the Club.

Section 8. **LIMITATION OF MEMBERSHIP:** The Officers shall have the authority to create, dissolve, or limit the number of members and the number of classes of membership as they deem advisable. The dues and privileges of the various classes of membership may not necessarily be equal between classes but shall be uniform within a class.

Section 9. **FEES:** All fees or dues are per household per school year. Full member of the Club dues shall be \$25. Fees or dues to be a Professional Member shall be \$10. Corporate Members of the Club shall consist of three levels, \$50 for Bronze, \$100 for Silver and \$200+ Gold Membership per business per school year.

ARTICLE VII
CLUB MEETINGS

- Section 1. **TIME:** There shall be one annual stated Club Membership Meeting each year. This meeting shall be held within the first two months of the fiscal year.
- Section 2. **REGULAR MEETINGS:** Full Members shall meet on the third (3rd) Tuesday of every month at 7:30 pm.
- Section 3. **SPECIAL MEETINGS:** The Secretary shall call special meetings at the discretion of the Head Coach or President, or upon the request of five (5) Club members in good standing.
- Section 4. **QUORUM:** One third of the members entitled to vote shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Only Full members in good standing shall have voting privileges.
- Section 5. **NOTICES:** Notices of Stated and Special Meetings shall be relayed to the Members by the Secretary at least 6 days in advance of said meeting.
- Section 6. **SPECIAL MEETING LIMITATIONS:** No business shall be transacted at a special meeting other than that for which notice was given.

ARTICLE VIII
ADOPTION OF BY-LAWS

- Section 1. **EXISTING CLUB PROCEDURE:** The President shall call the Club together and request the adoption of the By-Laws.
- Section 2. **ADDITIONS AND CHANGES TO EXISTING BY-LAWS:** May be made at a general meeting by verbal and/or written proposal. The proposal will then be taken under advisement by the Head Coach and Officers and reported back at the next general meeting for a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote required for acceptance.
- Section 3. **UPDATE OF BY-LAWS:** When deemed necessary, the President shall appoint a committee to update the Club's By-Laws. After approval by the Board, the updated By-Laws shall be presented at the next General Meeting for a two-thirds (2/3) affirmative vote by the members present and entitled to vote, at least to (10) days prior to the meeting.
- Section 4. **REVIEW TIME FRAME:** The Royal Oak High School Varsity Dance Team Booster Club By-Laws shall be reviewed at least every five (5) years.

ARTICLE IX
ORDER OF BUSINESS

- Section 1. **SEQUENCE:** At Stated and Special Meetings, the following order of business shall be observed:
1. Roll Call – Verbal or sign in sheet
 2. Reading of the Minutes of previous meeting
 3. Review and filing of the Treasurer's reports
 4. Reports of Officers
 5. Reports of Committees
 6. Election of Directors, if appropriate
 7. Old Business
 8. New Business
 9. Adjournment

ARTICLE X
RULES OF ORDER

- Section 1. **ORDER OF MOTIONS:** When a question is before the meeting, no motion shall be entertained except:
1. To adjourn
 2. To lay question on the table
 3. To review the previous question
 4. To postpone
 5. To commit and
 6. To amend
- When several motions shall have precedence in the order above given, and the first three shall be decided without debate.
- Section 2. **YEAS AND NAYS:** If any two members shall request it, the Yeas and Nays shall be called upon as each name is called, and the vote so taken shall be recorded in the Minutes.
- Section 3. **MAJORITY VOTE:** Except as otherwise provided, all questions shall be determined by a majority vote. The President shall have the deciding vote in the case of a tie, except when the yeas and nays are ordered in which case he/she shall vote when his/her name is called. If the result is then a tie, the motion shall be declared lost.
- Section 4. **ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER:** All questions of parliamentary practice not herein provided for, shall be determined in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order.

ARTICLE XI
LIABILITY

- Section 1. The Club shall not be held responsible for any injuries incurred by Club Members, Coaches, or Dance Team Members during any practice, performance, team activity, fundraiser, or any other event involving the Club.

ARTICLE XII
CONFLICT OF INTEREST

- Section 1. All Members shall abide by the Conflict of Interest policy attached.

ARTICLE XIII
POLICY OF NONDISCRIMINATION


- Section 1. All members shall abide by the Policy of Nondiscrimination. The ROHS Varsity Dance Team admits participants of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to participants. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its programs.

**ARTICLE XIV
DISSOLUTION**

Section 1. In the event of the dissolution of the Club for any reason, all of its assets and property shall be distributed, or sold and proceeds therefore distributed to the ROHS Varsity Dance Team. No distribution shall be made to an organization which does not have a ruling exempting it from federal income taxation. In no event shall any part of such assets or property, or the proceeds of sales thereof, be distributed to or inure to the benefit of any member of the Club or of any individual.






