RE: **Waiver of Delinquent Dog License Fee**

We will be hosting our 9<sup>th</sup> annual Rabies Vaccination Clinic in Royal Oak on Saturday, April 10, 2010 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the Department of Public Services. A licensed vet from the Oakland County Animal Shelter will administer the vaccinations and staff will issue the dog licenses. Last year we issued 217 licenses and vaccinated 198 dogs.

Our current policy has set a delinquent penalty of \$10 for those who are late in renewing their dog license. In the past, we have always offered an amnesty for this event from the delinquent penalty fee. The purpose of this event is to offer the residents an opportunity to get their pets vaccinated at a nominal fee of \$5 and licensed without penalty.

If the Commission is in agreement, the following resolution would be appropriate:

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Commission waives the delinquent penalty fee of \$10 on Saturday, April 10, 2010, during the Rabies Vaccination Clinic.
