Also seen are the old police station (house on Williams Street) and old City Hall on Third Street. This would become the super block of the new City Hall and Police Station. The new Daily Tribune building, Consumers Power building, and Detroit Edison building are seen in the next block south. The tall Michigan Bell Telephone building is yet another block south.
