RE: **Special Event – Woodward Dream Cruise – Uncle Ed’s Oil Shoppes – August 21, 2010**

Uncle Ed’s Oil Shoppes, is requesting permission to lease parking spaces in the parking lot of their property located at 31717 Woodward, on Saturday, August 21, 2010. This event is to occur in conjunction with the "Woodward Dream Cruise" on Saturday, August 21, 2010.

The staff has had discussions involving details of the event with Dennis Coggins of Uncle Ed’s Oil Shoppes, Inc.

Listed below are the specifics of a proposed agreement between the City and Uncle Ed’s Oil Shoppe:

I. **Hours of Operation**

This event would run from 10am to 9pm Saturday, August 21, 2010 with set-up beginning at 8am. Ongoing clean-up would occur throughout the day.

II. **Description of Event**

This event would be a one day lease of parking spaces to Woodward Dream Cruise participants.

III. **Parking Control**

Parking will be provided for those that lease spaces.

IV. **Insurance**

A Certificate of Insurance for \$1 Million combined single limits coverage has been provided to the City by Uncle Ed’s Oil Shoppes, Inc., with the City named as additional insured.

V. **Impact on Adjacent CommercialResidential Property**

Organizers anticipate that there will be little impact on the adjacent commercial and residential properties.

VI. **Music**

There will be no music provided for this event.

VII. **Restroom Facilities**

Restrooms will not be provided at this event.

VIII. **Food and Beverage**

There will be no food or beverages provided at this event. There will be no alcoholic beverages served, sold or consumed at this event.

IX. **Booths/Tents/Awnings**

There will be no booths, tents or awnings associated with this event.

X. **Tables/Grills/Refuse Barrels**

There will be no tables or grills at this event. Refuse barrels will be on site.

XI. **Signs – Alcoholic Beverages**

Any inflatable device used to advertise an alcoholic beverage will not be permitted for this event. For all other inflatable devices (non-alcoholic) as well as any signs, banners, etc., the applicant and/or organizers are required to obtain the necessary permits and/or approvals from Inspection Department, Code Enforcement, or any other appropriate department.

XII. **Clean-Up Procedures**

Refuse will be picked up throughout the day.

XIII. **City Involvement**

It is not anticipated that the City of Royal Oak, will need to provide anything for the event being hosted by Uncle Ed's Oil Shoppes, Inc.

However, in the event of any unanticipated circumstance connected in any way to this special event, which necessitates alerting of and/or deployment of police officers, Uncle Ed's Oil Shoppes, Inc., agrees to reimburse all related expenses incurred by the City. Police personnel will be monitoring traffic flow at this location as well as several others during the "Woodward Dream Cruise".

XIV. **Fire Protection**

Event promoters will provide full access to this area for emergency vehicles, which will allow entry response for fire, medical emergency or police related needs.

XV. **Revocation**

Uncle Ed's Oil Shoppes, Inc., acknowledges that operations under this permit will cease immediately upon notification from the Chief of Police or his designee, that in the judgment of the Chief of Police or his designee, continued operation would pose a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the general public.

XVI. **Special Event Permit Fee**

The \$200.00 Special Event Permit fee was paid at the City Clerk's Office on June 21, 2010.

The following resolution is recommended for approval:

Be It Resolved that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the attached agreement between the City of Royal Oak and Uncle Ed's Oil Shoppes, Inc., to lease parking spaces in the parking lot of their property located at 31717 Woodward.
