When officers made contact with the subject through his closed door, he refused to come out and stated he would shoot any officer that entered his apartment. Officers backed off and established a perimeter to contain the subject until the SWAT Team could respond. SWAT Negotiators were unable to talk the subject out of the apartment. The SWAT Team deployed gas into the apartment, the subject exited the apartment and was taken into custody without further incident. The subject was transported to the Hospital for evaluation. 10-1852

300 Block of N. Rembrandt, 5/07/10, 10:30 pm: Officers responded to a Domestic Disturbance call. Upon arrival officers were met outside the residence by the homeowner. The homeowner stated her son was inside the home and was intoxicated, assaultive, highly agitated and suicidal. The subject was also armed with a knife and was alone with a 4 year old in the house. Officers immediately surrounded the house to contain the subject until other officers could arrive. Officers were able to make contact with the subject and saw he was armed with a large knife. The subject said if any officers tried to come in he would kill them and himself. As officers were attempting to negotiate with the subject, there was an opportunity to deploy the taser. The subject was tasered and officers forced entry into the home and were able to take the subject into custody. The subject was transported to the Hospital for evaluation. 10-1861
