Please help us diversify our growing collection of native plants, and see the progress underway in our Oak Savanna.

**Event Info:** RONS will assist the donors on "Share a Savanna Plant Day" by collecting proper labels & analyzing locations within the Oak Savanna gardens to authenticate and site the plants. Please bring labels, (popsicle sticks ok), a shovel, trowel & rake to plant!

**Plant Info:** Please dig your plants as close to 10/2 as possible. Please label them with Genus, species, or at least common name. Please also include the ORIGINAL source on the label as well – Example: Oakland Wildflower Farm, Ortonville, MI, or wild collected, Troy, MI. There will be skilled botanists on hand to assist you at the arboretum in the case where it's native but not sure exactly what!
