### **ZMC Pharmacy Burglary Suspect Arrested!!**

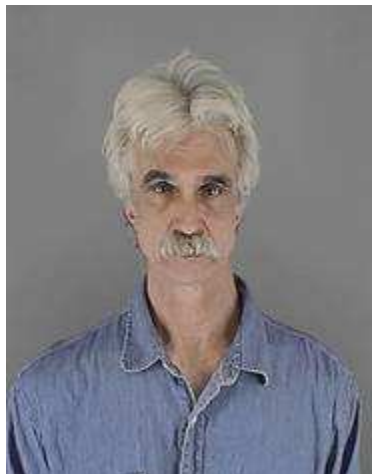
On January 4, 2011, at approximately 3:25 am, Royal Oak police officers responded to a report of a burglary that just occurred. An eyewitness reported they had just observed three masked people, one holding an axe, run out of ZMC Pharmacy, 1041 S. Main. The suspects then threw three boxes into the trunk of a running vehicle and sped away. The witness was able to obtain a license plate number from the getaway vehicle.

Officers arrived on scene at ZMC Pharmacy and observed the front door glass had been smashed out, and discovered that numerous bottles of prescription medication had been stolen. The suspect vehicle was not located.

On January 11, 2011, at approximately 11:00 am, Royal Oak patrol officers located the suspects' vehicle and vehicle's owner, Douglas Ross Cook, 56-years-old, resident of Highland Park. During the traffic stop, officers located several bottles of prescription medication that was stolen from the Pharmacy.

Mr. Cook is being charged with one (1) count of Burglary (10 year felony), and one (1) count of Receiving Stolen Property (5 year felony).

On January 13, 2011, Cook was arraigned by 44<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge Terrence Brennan. Bond was set at \$50,000 and the Preliminary-Exam is set for January 21, 2011 at 8:30 am.
