Auto Theft:

400 block of S. Dorchester, 3/10/2011, 8:15 pm: Royal Oak Police Department and Michigan Department of Corrections conducted a collaborative review of released prisoners residing in Royal Oak. This mission is called "Operation Nighthawk." This joint effort monitors parolees in their homes to make sure they don't do something against their conditions of release, and to keep our neighborhoods safe.

The officers will stop at parolees' homes unannounced and visit for five to ten minutes. The officers will review the parolee's condition of release which may include performing

breathalyzer tests. Additionally, the officers will look for contraband such as drugs, alcohol and firearms.

In total "Operation Nighthawk" visited twelve (12) residents and at this particular location the parolee was arrested on a Civil Warrant for Neglect of Child and Failure to Appear on a Misdemeanor Charge. There were no other arrests to report. 11-759

Parking Structure, 514 S. Lafayette, 3/10/2011, 10:18 am: Central Business District assigned officers observed a male sitting inside a vehicle and smoking marijuana. The suspect was arrested for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia. 11-761
