

**City of Royal Oak Policy for  
PLACEMENT OF UNLICENSED VEHICLES, MOBILE STORAGE  
DEVICES, TRASH RECEPTACLES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF  
CONTAINERS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY (STREET)**

**NOTE:** For construction projects, Licensed Vehicles do not require special permits to be placed on a City of Royal Oak public street. Licensed vehicles shall have up to date current registered plates and tags. Vehicles such as Dump Trucks or trailers fall into this category. Item 5 below also applies where applicable.

To install or place a TRASH RECEPTACLE, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICE, DUMPSTER OR ROLL-OFF CONTAINER on City of Royal Oak Public Property:

1. A **City of Royal Oak - Right-of-way Permit** is required. The permit has the following conditions that must be met prior to issuance:
  - a. Liability Insurance as outlined in the permit application must be secured with the appropriate coverage limits, additional insured and cancellation notice.
  - b. A cash bond of no less than \$2,000 or as determined by the Engineer to cover any type of damage to city property.
  - c. Payment of all required permit application fees and inspection fees which are for a minimum of 4 hours of inspection or as determined by the Engineer.
  - d. A plan indicating the location of the TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS shall be submitted for review which shall include adequate dimensions and notations to indicate existing features, parking meters, special parking regulations in the vicinity of placement adjacent trees and utility poles/street lights.
2. The TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS shall be placed on a paved roadway that is signed to legally allow for vehicle parking. ***Placement in Public alleys is highly discouraged.*** They shall not be installed on or across public sidewalk, or landscaped areas of right-of-way.
3. The TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS shall be properly barricaded with LIGHTED Type II barricades in sufficient number as determined by the Engineer.
4. Planking, approved by the Engineer, must be placed on the pavement below the wheels, tracks, slides or supports of the TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS to protect the pavement.
5. When TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS and related barricading placed in public parking spaces regulated with parking meters, all public parking spaces blocked from use shall be paid for the duration of the installation *in advance at the City Treasurers Department*.
6. The TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS shall be covered with appropriate tarps or covers when not in active filling activities.
7. Upon removal of the TRASH RECEPTACLES, MOBILE STORAGE DEVICES, DUMPSTERS AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS, the Public right-of-way shall be properly repaired or restored, including all pavements and landscaping if necessary, and cleaned of all debris prior to refund of all bonds.
