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<p>Placement on Agenda</p> <p>The application fee should be paid to: "City of Royal Oak", at the Treasurer's Office, on the first floor of the City Hall Building.</p> <p>After all required information has been provided and reviewed by the necessary departments, including Planning, Engineering, Building Inspection, Public Services, Police and/or Fire Departments, the request will be scheduled for consideration at the next available City Commission agenda.</p> <p>Applicant or representative must be present at all meeting(s).</p> <p>Charter of the City of Royal Oak, Chapter 13, Section 2 states: "When the Commission shall deem it advisable to vacate, discontinue, or abolish any street, alley, or public ground, or any part thereof, they shall, by resolution, so declare and in the same resolution shall appoint a time, not less than four weeks thereafter, when they shall meet and hear objections thereto. Notice of such meeting, with a copy of said resolution, shall be published once, not less than two weeks before the time appointed for such meeting, in a newspaper published and circulating in the City"</p>
